Job Description

Position Title: Maintenance Technician
Reports to: Facility Continuous Improvement Manager

Job Summary

The Maintenance Technician's core responsibilities include troubleshooting, servicing and rebuilding manufacturing equipment, performing machine maintenance and medium duty electrical work on plant equipment and other job duties as assigned by the Facilities Continuous Improvement Manager.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Perform preventative maintenance on all equipment in the plant, including company vehicles.
- Perform monthly safety inspections and record keeping.
- Read work orders and specifications to determine machines and equipment requiring repair.
- Install, replace or change machine parts and attachments, according to production specification.
- Reassemble machines after the completion of repair or maintenance work.
- Dismantle machines and remove parts for repair, using hand tools, chain falls, jacks, cranes, or hoists.
- Collaborate with other workers to repair or move machines, parts and equipment.
- Operate cranes, drills, saws and other small tools as required.
- Carry out various clerical or janitorial duties.
- Record production, repair, and machine maintenance information.
- Set up and operate machines, and adjust controls to regulate operations.
- Must follow all safety rules and keep work area clean and safe from hazards at all times.

Qualifications

- Working knowledge of electricity, hydraulics, and pneumatics.
- Frequently lifting and carrying up to 45 pounds.
- Frequently walking, stooping, balancing, reaching and climbing.
- Frequent use of tools such as those listed under position responsibilities.
- Work requires individuals with good vision and communication.
- Must be able to braise and solder and some welding.
