



## Quality Control Technician

**Position Title: Quality Control Technician**

### **Job Summary:**

The Quality Technician is responsible for the inspection and testing of our products, including wall panels, plank, beams and also columns throughout the production lifecycle, to ensure conformance with all PCI standards. This position is critical to ensuring the quality and safety of our products at Mid-States Concrete.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Follows instructions, guidelines and procedures timely and accurately.
- Assist with day-to-day operations with the Quality Control Department.
- Able to work as a team member with production management to ensure a team effort and focus.
- Interpret and implement PCI standards.
- Continually and actively seek to learn new skills and progress in level of responsibility.
- Bring quality issues and discrepancies to other employees and management team.
- Work in such a way as to ensure the highest quality products are shipped to our customers.
- Inspects concrete beds and forms prior to concrete pouring.
- Checks dimensions of various product aspects including numbers, size and position of reinforcing steel and other incorporated materials.
- Performs regular inspection of concrete mixing, placing compaction, finishing and curing.
- Prepares concrete specimens for testing. Regularly performs test for slump, air content and cylinder strength.

### **Physical Requirements:**

- Regularly works near moving mechanical parts and in outside conditions that include inclement weather, heat and humidity, and exposure to dust and concrete.
- Must be able to lift, push, pull, or carry objects of up to 45 pounds, and use abdominal and lower back muscles to provide support over time without fatigue.
- Requires good manual dexterity (hand, hand with arm, two hands) and multi-limb coordination.
- Noise level is generally loud.
- Must be able to quickly move arms and legs.
- Excellent stamina is required.

### **Qualifications:**

- Must be able to read a tape measure.
- Must be able to work any start time/schedule as required by the needs of production.
- Must be able to understand and follow SWIs.

- Must be able to take responsibility for generating positive outcomes and demonstrate ownership.
- Must be able to read and speak English.
- Honesty, integrity, and a strong desire to succeed.
- Excellent organizational and communication skills.
- Ability to create and maintain cooperative team building relationships.
- Ability to meet deadlines and work under pressure.
